

CPC Map Data Sharing Agreement

Terms and Conditions

1. Upon approval of a Data Use Request, the Provider shall provide access to the dataset described in the approved Data Use Request (the “Data”) to the Recipient for the purposes set forth in approved Data Use Request. Provider shall retain ownership of any rights it may have in the Data, and Recipient does not obtain any rights in the Data other than as set forth herein.
2. Recipient shall not use the Data except as authorized under this Agreement. The Data will be used solely to conduct the Project and solely by the Recipient and Recipient’s collaborators (defined in Section 4 of the Data Use Agreement Request) that have a need to use, or provide a service in respect of, the Data in connection with the Project and whose obligations of use are consistent with the terms of this Agreement (collectively, “Authorized Persons”).
3. Except as authorized under this Agreement or otherwise required by law, Recipient agrees to retain control over the Data and shall not disclose, release, sell, rent, lease, loan, or otherwise grant access to the Data to any third party, except Authorized Persons, without the prior written consent of Provider. Recipient agrees to establish appropriate administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to prevent unauthorized use of or access to the Data and comply with any other special requirements relating to safeguarding of the Data as may be set forth in Decision About Data Use.
4. Recipient agrees to use the Data in compliance with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations, as well as all professional standards applicable to such research.
5. The agreement is not transferable to other studies or other investigators. Substantive changes made to the project (including, but not limited to, inclusion of other collaborators who will have access to the data, changes in institutional affiliations, changes in the scope of the study) will require a new agreement.
6. Recipient agrees to recognize the contribution of the Provider as the source of the Data in all written, visual, or oral public disclosures concerning Recipient’s research using the Data, as appropriate in accordance with scholarly standards and using the citation listed in the “Data Description” section of the Data Use Request.
7. This Agreement shall expire as of the End Date set forth in the Decision About Data Use. Either party may terminate this Agreement with thirty (30) days written notice. Upon expiration or early termination of this Agreement, Recipient shall destroy any dataset provided by the CPC Map Team, provided, however, that Recipient may retain one (1) copy of the Data to the extent necessary for the purposes of research integrity and verification.
